## **About BHRS Points**

British Heart Rhythm Society (formerly known as Heart Rhythm UK) is dedicated to improving all aspects of arrhythmia care and electrical device based therapies along with acting as a unifying focus for those professionals involved.

The society was formed in 2005 by the amalgamation of the British Pacing and Electrophysiology Group (BPEG), the British Association of Arrhythmia Nurses (BANA) and the UK Interventional Electrophysiology Society (UKICES). Membership is made up of clinicians, cardiac physiologists, specialist nurses and others involved in cardiac rhythm management (CRM). With over 1000 members across the UK and further, BHRS points are a great opportunity to demonstrate the education value of your CRM courses and events.

BHRS points are awarded to help accredited members towards their 5-year reaccreditation goal. Courses aimed at refreshing basic knowledge or exam preparation courses, are usually not eligible for BHRS points unless there is advanced educational content. Applications are considered for award of points/CPD purely towards BHRS reaccreditation.



### Guidelines

Applications for BHRS points should only be **submitted by course organisers/education leads**. You may claim BHRS points for attending or presenting at a scientific meeting (see relevant BHRS points table).

Events should have a **minimum of 2 hours of relevant education** content to be eligible for BHRS points.

Regular (monthly/weekly) hospital departmental education sessions with at least 1 hour of relevant education content will considered for BHRS points. In these instances terms of reference must be submitted by the department's education lead, Principal Cardiac Physiologist or CRM service lead.

If your event is repeated within the calendar year, you can include all dates on one application form.

BHRS points can only be awarded to event dates/hospital departmental education sessions by the BHRS accreditation committee and will not be automatically awarded to subsequent dates.

A certificate of attendance will be required by any individual attending an event and wishing to utilise BHRS points for reaccreditation. For proof of attendance at departmental education sessions, a signed letter from your manager detailing the number of sessions attended will be required.

The departments education lead must be an active Maximum 10 BHRS points per individual accredited BHRS member (over 5 years).
